Class 1 **Hunter Brood Mare** with foal at foot or Due to Foal in 2019 **FOALS MUST BE LED**

Class 1A **Foal** (Progeny of Mare in Class 1) ---No Entry Fee .Prizes Rosettes.

Class 2 **1 y.o. Colt, Gelding or Filly**, likely to make a Hunter.

Class 3 **2 y.o. Colt, Gelding or Filly**, likely to make a Hunter.

Class 4 **3 y.o. Colt, Gelding or Filly**, likely to make a Hunter.

If **ONLY ONE** Entry in Any of the Above Classes 2 - 4, they will be Amalgamated.

Class 5 **Coloured colt, gelding or filly-** Shown in Hand - Any Age

Class 6 **Pure Bred Irish Draft 1, 2 or 3yo** to be led. Passports to be shown.

Class 13 A **FAMILY PONY / COB / HORSE** – Riders under 16. **no lead rein allowed.**

Class 13 B **FAMILY PONY / COB / HORSE** –Riders over 16. Same animal may not compete in both 13A and 13B

Class 14 **Coloured Ridden** Open to Any Coloured Horse or Pony. **Riders any age but no lead rein allowed.**

**RING 2 Pony Showing Classes - Start 10.00am Prizes £10, £7, £4. Entry Fee £8**

Class 15 **LEADING REIN-** Ponies 4y o and over, not exceeding 123cms. Suitable for and to be ridden by child under 7 years on 1st January, 2019

Class 16 **FAMILY PONY LEADING REIN-** Ponies 4y o and over, not exceeding 133cms. To be ridden by child under 8 years on 1st January, 2019. **Winner of Class 15 Pony or Rider not Eligible.**

Class 17 **FIRST RIDDEN-** Ponies 4 y o and over, not exceeding 128cms; Riders under 12 years on 1st January, 2019

Class 18 **Mountain & Moorland RIDDEN** - (No Lead Rein)

Class will be divided into small and large breeds if sufficient entries. Open to Any Fully Registered animal. Passports to be Produced.

Class 19 **Ridden Show Hunter Pony** under 148cms, riders under 16 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019
