EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY The Society, being a charitable institution, which organises the Show to promote Agriculture and its ancillary industries within Northern Ireland requires all entrants and exhibitors as a fundamental condition of entry to undertake and accept that the Society shall not be liable in any way for any claim for compensation or otherwise which may arise out of our being connected with the Show including without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the holding, abandonment or alteration of the date of the Show, omission of any entry, the rejection or removal of any animal or other exhibit, the removal or exclusion of any owner, groom, rider or attendant from the show or the appointment, decision, act or omission of any Judge, Officer, Official, Employee or other person connected with the Show nor shall the Society nor any of its Judges, Officers, Officials, Employees or other persons be in any way responsible or accountable for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to the Exhibitor or their Attendants, or to any exhibit or property brought into the Show Grounds or for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Society's Show. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other Loss, Injury or Damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or item exhibited by Him, and for its description as given in the Catalogue. Exhibitors shall indemnify the Society against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.

HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK (NI) ORDER 1978

In compliance with the above Order, CLASS Ltd has produced a Health and Safety Policy Document, a copy of which will be available from the Secretary in the Show Office. Responsibility is placed on all Exhibitors, Trade or Stock, for their own Personal Safety, Fellow Exhibitors and All Other Persons (including the General Public) who have Reason to be present. Exhibitors should acquaint themselves with the Rules and Regulations and follow Instructions given to Exhibitors. It is assumed that all exhibitors will endeavour to comply with the rules laid down in this document. This is to ensure safe and healthy working conditions for its employees or other persons, who are present on premises and grounds occupied by the Show during the Agricultural Show. By completing an entry form, an exhibitor is deemed to accept and comply with all Regulations and Instructions as described under the Rules and Regulations of the Joint Show. No Child under the Age of 12 will be allowed to handle or lead Bulls or other Large Animals. No Children will be allowed to accompany Handlers during the Parade of Prize-winners.

LIVESTOCK RULES

1. All Entries must be accompanied by fees and all particulars required on Entry Forms must be fully stated and the Exhibits must be those described on the Form.
2. All Exhibits must be Bona-fide Property of the Exhibitors at the time of entry and for at least 28 days prior to the Show. Any Exhibitor found guilty of infringing this Rule will forfeit all Prize Money and may be debarred from showing for a period of not more than 5 years.
3. Exhibits must be ready for Judging at 9.30a.m., on the morning of the Show when only Judges and Stewards will be allowed in the Judging Areas.
4. The Grounds will be open at 8.00a.m. and all Animals must be in the Field before 9.00a.m. Stock for Exhibition may not be admitted after that hour.
5. **NO STOCK MAY LEAVE THE SHOWGROUNDS UNTIL AFTER PARADE OF PRIZEWINNERS (NOT BEFORE 3.00P.M.). ALL PRIZEWINNERS MUST TAKE PART IN THE PARADE AFTER THE JUDGING IS OVER. ANY PRIZEWINNING ANIMALS NOT APPEARING IN THE PARADE WILL FORFEIT PRIZE MONEY.**
6. Prize money and rosettes will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in any given Class.
7. Every Precaution will be taken, but the Committee will not be responsible for Loss or Accidents of any kind which may occur, either to Exhibits, Exhibitors, Visitors or otherwise.
8. Any Complaint or Objection regarding Exhibits or any other matter must be made in Writing to the Secretary within One Hour after Judging and must be accompanied by a Deposit of £5.00 which will be Forfeited if, in the Opinion of the Sub-committee, the Complaint is Frivolous
9. Committee reserve the right not to refund entry fees where an Exhibitor withdraws their entries.
10. 'Overstocking' or 'Hafting' of Milk Cows will entail immediate Disqualification. The Judge of the class is empowered to Disqualify or have Milked in the Ring any Exhibit.
11. No Person whatever shall in any way communicate with a Judge engaged in Adjudication without the Previous Sanction of the Steward in Attendance. If a Herd or other Attendant infringes this Rule, he shall be immediately Removed from the Charge of the Exhibit, and another Herd or Attendant shall be Substituted by the Steward. Any Exhibitor who enters the Space in which adjudication is Proceeding may be Disqualified from receiving a Prize.
12. The Judges are instructed to withhold a Prize when Sufficient Merit does not appear. if any Judge is unable to fulfil his Engagement, the Committee reserves to itself the right to Appoint another in his place, or additional ones if required and to make alterations necessary to the Success of the Show.

13. Any Act of Discourtesy or Disobedience to the Officials on the part of the Owner or the Servant will Disqualify the Animal from adjudication or taking a Prize.
14. The Committee shall have power as required to create New Classes of Exhibits or to modify amalgamate or change Existing Classes or to Dispense with the Continuance of any Class, Classes or Exhibits or to modify any Conditions pertaining to the Award of any Cup or Prize. Exhibitors will be notified on Show Day. No Entry Fees will be Refunded should this occur.
15. Should any matter arising not be provided for in the Preview of these Rules and Regulations, such Matters shall be referred to the Committee, of which Five Members shall form a Quorum, whose Decision shall be Final and Binding, no Appeal to Law in any case being permitted.
16. No Exhibitor shall wear a Steward's Badge while leading an animal for adjudication in the Ring.
17. The Society will not in any way be liable for any Claim for compensation or otherwise arising out of the Holding, Abandonment or the Alteration of the Date of the Show, nor for any other claim arising out of or connected with the Show.
18. All Animals must be provided with a Suitable Head Stall or Halter and Bulls must be secured by a Ring or Screw in the Nose with a Chain or Rope attached. No Tickets will be given for Servants or Caretakers. One Servant or Caretaker only for each lot will be admitted and must continue in charge of this Lot. All Exhibits to be distinguished by Numbers only, which will be supplied by the Secretary.
19. The Show Committee reserves to itself the Power to reject any Entry or Remove any Animal from the Show without being in any way liable for compensation and reserve the right to Class in any Section.
20. No Exhibit in Home Industries Sections may be Removed before 4.00p.m. on Saturday 19th July.
21. All Cups, except for those which have been won outright, must be Returned to the Secretary not later than 07th June 2025.
22. The Committee reserve the right to Amalgamate or Divide Classes as deemed necessary. Exhibitors will be notified on day of Show. No Entry Fees will be refunded, if this happens. The Committee reserves the Right to cancel any Class if there are Insufficient Entries
23. **No Cups will be presented until after the Parade of Prize-winners.**
24. All Challenge Cups to be won three times in Succession by the Same Exhibitor before becoming his property.
25. All Cup Winners are advised that they should have relevant insurance.
26. All stock exhibits (except sheep) must wear numbers in the Show Ring, as per catalogue. Numbers to be **collected** from Show Secretary on Show Day.

CATTLE EXHIBITORS

IMPORTANT - Exhibitors should ensure that the correct EAR TAG NUMBER is recorded on the ENTRY FORM/ PERMIT (MC2) / and ANIMAL, otherwise Entries will not be accepted.

All cattle entered must be from **OFFICIALLY BRUCELLOSIS AND TUBERCULOSIS FREE HERDS** and each animal must be accompanied by the Official Movement Permit to include 30-day Brucellosis Testing Result Letter which must cover Show Day. This applies to all Animals over 12 months old. A Calf shown with its dam must be the Cow's Own Calf, not an embryo, be under 10 months old on Show Day and full details of Calf must be included on Entry Form.

ANIMALS WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY THE CORRECT PAPERWORK - Cattle must not be unloaded until all Paperwork has been checked and Cleared by Stewards. **Only then will Numbers be issued. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS. ANY EXHIBITOR WHO CONTRAVENES THE ABOVE SHALL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY FURTHER ACTIONS THAT MAY FOLLOW.**

Drivers outside a radius of 65km must have an Animal Transporter Authorisation Certificate.

PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE: All Exhibitors must hold valid public Liability Insurance for Individual (or Family Insurance if under 18) for Livestock Present on Show Day.

Cattle born on or after 1st March 2026 must have returned a **NEGATIVE BVD** test result, prior to appearing at the show.

CLYDESDALE HORSE SOCIETY SHIELD - A Shield (which will be supplied and engraved by the Clydesdale Horse Society) will be awarded to the **BEST YEARLING** or **TWO-YEAR-OLD COLT or FILLY**, registered or eligible for registration with the Society, not having won a Shield before in its lifetime. The Exhibitor must be a Current Member of the Clydesdale Horse Society.

Prize money in the Ridden Clydesdale, Turnouts and young handlers has been kindly sponsored by **Co. Londonderry Horse Breeding Society**.

OB CONSTRUCTION/NISA CLYDESDALE CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

The Northern Ireland Shows Association Clydesdale Championships 2026 will be sponsored by OB Construction. The Championship will run on a league basis, and points will be awarded for animals placed in their respective classes.

Eligible Classes – Brood Mare having produced a foal in 2026. Foal born on or after 1st January 2026. Gelding 3 years old and upwards. Yeld Mare 3 years old and upwards. Colt or Gelding 2 years old. Filly 2 years old. Colt or Gelding 1 year old, Filly 1 year old.

Points: 1st (5 points), 2nd (4 points) and 3rd (3 points). In addition, all horses forward in a class will be awarded one point. These points, together with those gained at other NISA member shows staging the relevant Clydesdale classes during the 2026 show season, will be totalled, but where more than one show (having heavy horse classes) takes place on the same day, points gained will only count from one of these shows, the highest gained points on the day will count.

Exhibitors must include the passport name of their animal(s), exhibitor name, address, and contact details with each exhibitor entry. Trophies will be awarded to the exhibitors of the six horses with the highest points over the league. Qualifying shows: Ballymena, Ballymoney, Saintfield, Omagh, Castlewellan, Limavady and Antrim Shows.

CO LONDONDERRY HORSE BREEDING SOCIETY CLYDESDALE YOUNG HANDLERS' CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

Points will be awarded to Young Handlers at CLHBS Clydesdale Foal Show 2025, then in 2026 – at Balmoral, Ballymoney, Saintfield, Ballymena, Castlerock, Limavady, Castlewellan, Antrim and Garvagh shows. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st (5), 2nd (4), 3rd (3), all other young handlers forward will receive 2 points. Points will be totalled, and prizes given out at CLHBS Foal Show 2026.

An Engraved Medal will be presented by the Clydesdale Horse Society to the **BEST YOUNG HANDLER** aged 12 to 16 on the day of the Show who has not already qualified. That person will also receive a Young Handler qualifier rosette on the day of the show. The Capabilities of the Handler are to be assessed and **NOT** the animal being led.

Qualifiers from any show held prior to 30th April in any year will qualify for the Young Handler final at the Royal Highland Show in the year of that show. Qualifiers after 30th April in any year will qualify for the Young Handler final at the following year's Royal Highland Show. A merit rosette will be given to all entrants in the class.

IMPORTANT: All Stock entered in this Section must have Name and Ear Number of Animal on Entry Form. Animals **MUST** be from Brucellosis Certified Herds and Movement Permits will be required to be produced on Day of Show as Ear Numbers have to be Checked.

All exhibitors must comply with current DARD rules regarding livestock movement and biosecurity.

- RULES**
1. Cows in milk should either be shown with a calf at foot or her calf should at least be at the Show
 2. All cows shown should have produced a calf naturally within the last 15 months.
 3. Any animal, which has been used as an embryo transfer donor, cannot be shown until she has produced a calf by natural birth and then will follow on from Rule 2 above.
 4. A Heifer becomes a Cow once she has had a Calf.
 5. No Animal can be entered in more than One Class

An Animal cannot be entered in the Native or Continental Cattle Classes if there is a relevant Breed Class provided.

NISA PEDIGREE JUNIOR BULL CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

- For the Best Pedigree Junior Bull born on or after 1st January 2025.

NISA Pedigree Junior Bull Championship Final is being held this year at Clogher Valley Show on 29th July 2026. All exhibitors wishing to qualify for this Championship must enter the name of their animal(s) and exhibitor details, in their respective class at the qualifying Shows. Only the 1st & 2nd placed exhibits in Junior Bull Classes at Limavady Show are eligible to go forward to the NISA Pedigree Junior Bull qualifier that day.

To maximise attendance of qualified exhibits at the Championship Final, those who qualify must confirm their intention to be present at Clogher Valley Show on 29th July 2026 for the Championship Final. In the event of qualified exhibitors not wishing to attend the Final, the next placed animal will qualify.

No exhibitor may qualify more than **two** exhibits for the Championship Final. Animals **cannot** qualify at Clogher Valley Show for the Championship.

NISA will present rosettes to the exhibitors for both qualifying animals at each qualifying show and Champion & Reserve Champion Rosettes at the Final

Prize money at the Final:

1st £300, 2nd £200, 3rd £100, 4th £50

Prize money will be forwarded to the named exhibitor following the Final. It is important that all those who qualify register their intention to attend the Final with the NISA administrator.

The Qualifying Shows for the NISA Junior Bull Championship are: -
