- 1 Exhibits must be staged on **Friday 17th July up to 6.00 p.m.** (after which no entries will be accepted) and be ready for **Judging at 6.30 p.m.**, when only judges and stewards will be allowed to remain in the marquee.
- 2 Exhibitors from a distance can have their Exhibits staged by Stewards provided that they are addressed to the Home Industries' Secretary and delivered (carriage paid) by 6.30p.m. on Thursday 16th July.
- 3 THE NUMBER OF PRIZES AWARDED IN EACH CLASS WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE.
- 4 Any complaint or objection with regard to Exhibits or any other matter **MUST BE MADE IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY NOT LATER THAN 11.00a.m. ON SATURDAY 18th July ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF £2.00 WHICH WILL BE FORFEITED IF THE OBJECTION IS NOT SUSTAINED.**
- 5 Should any Dispute arise, for which a special rule is not provided, such matter in dispute shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final and in no case can there be an appeal to law.
- 6 Labels for Entry Forms received by post may be collected at the Secretary's Office. Entry forms to be completed by exhibitor prior to exhibit labels being filled in. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring all details on exhibit labels are correct at time of entry. Labels must be securely attached to each Exhibit.
- 7 While the Committee will exercise every care, all Exhibits, Exhibitors, Officials, Spectators and Personal Property etc. will be at the risk of the Exhibitors. The Committee will not be liable for compensation for loss or damage by theft or any other causes.
